ONLINE REGISTRATION:

Registration for all categories will take place online at the Skate NL registration website: https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com. Methods of payment include: VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. Pre-paid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Thursday, February 23, 2023, at 10:00AM **Registration Deadline:** Sunday, March 5, 2023, at 11:59PM

Late entries will not be accepted.

REFUND POLICY: Refund requests must be made by **Sunday, March 5, 2023**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within 14 days following the Event. There will be no refunds given, for any reason, for individuals withdrawing from Team Events.



ASSESSMENT QUALIFICATIONS:

Assessment requirements must be met at the time of online registration.

AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Age is considered to be the age of the skater before July 1, preceding the event.

MUSIC:

If applicable, music must be submitted electronically with online registration. *Please ensure correct music files are uploaded.* Music file changes and mislabeled music files will be charged a \$25 administrative fee. Skaters/Coaches should have a **USB** copy of music available at ice level, during the Event. CD's, phones, or other personal devices will **NOT** be accepted.

MUSIC UPLOAD INFORMATION:

- Music files <u>must</u> be MP3.
- Music uploads must be named in the following format: First Name Last Name Category
- First and Last Name **must** match the athlete's name as written on their Uplifter profile.

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

SCHEDULE:

CERTIFICATE PRESENTATIONS:

All skaters in **Skate to Standard** categories will receive an evaluation certificate & report card, to be presented following the completion of the category, at an announced time.
