ONLINE REGISTRATION:

Registration will take place on the Skate Canada NL Registration website: https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com Methods of payment include VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. PrePaid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Tuesday, October 4, 2022, at 10:00AM

Registration Deadline: Thursday, October 13, 2022

Late entries will NOT be accepted.

REFUND POLICY: Refund requests must be made by **Thursday, October 13, 2022**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within **14 days** following the Event.

ASSESSMENT QUALIFICATIONS:

Assessment requirements should be met at the time of online registration.

AGE RESTRICTIONS:

Age is the age of the skater before July 1, preceding the Event.



MUSIC:

All music will be submitted electronically following online registration. Music files must be .mp3 and labeled as "Skaters Name_Category_Age Category". Skaters should also have a CD copy of music available at ice level, during the Event.

COACHES ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

SCHEDULE:

A detailed schedule will be posted on the Skate Canada NL website (<u>Agnes Thistle Invitational – Skate Canada – Newfoundland & Labrador (skatenl.com)</u> as soon as possible after the registration deadline.

MEDALS:

Medals shall be awarded to the top three placements in each category, with the exception of STAR 2 and STAR 3. In a category where there are less than three entries, the number of medals awarded shall equal the number of entries.

MEDAL PRESENTATIONS: Medals presentations will be scheduled following the official results. **Skaters** are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.

CERTIFICATE PRESENTATIONS: All skaters in **STAR 2 and STAR 3** will receive an evaluation certificate & report card, to be presented following the completion of the results for each group.
