- All categories are subject to the availability of officials.
- The following categories will be judged virtually, following the Event, and discounted 50% of the registration fee:
 - PreNovice-Senior Solo Ice Dance
 - Juvenile-Senior Partnered Ice Dance
 - STAR 6 & Gold Partnered Free Dance
 - All Pairs categories
- Included is an \$8.00 officials and technology development fee (ODF) per skater. The ODF is charged only once per skater and will be discounted for skaters in multiple categories.
- **Partnered Dance/Pairs:** Each skater must register separately and ensure their Uplifter profile is up to date with partner details.
- **Junior and Senior:** The Agnes Thistle Invitational is the qualifying Event for the Skate Canada Challenge Event

**ONLINE REGISTRATION:**

Registration will take place on the Skate Canada NL Registration website: <https://skatenf.uplifterinc.com>
Methods of payment include VISA, MasterCard and Discover Card. PrePaid VISA/MasterCard gift cards are also accepted.

Registration Opens: Tuesday, September 1, at NOON

Registration Deadline: Thursday, September 10, 2026 * Late entries will NOT be accepted.

REFUND POLICY:

Refund requests must be made by **Thursday, September 10, 2026**. After this date, all refunds will require a medical note and are subject to a \$25 administration fee. Medical notes must be submitted within **14 days** following the Event.

MUSIC:

All music must be submitted electronically with online registration. Please ensure correct music files are uploaded. Music file changes and mislabeled music files will be charged a \$25 administrative fee.
Skaters/Coaches should have a **USB** copy of music available at ice level, during the Event. CD's, phones, or other personal devices will **NOT** be accepted.

MUSIC UPLOAD INFORMATION:

- Music must be submitted for **all** categories/segments (ie: short program, free program etc.).
- Music files **must** be MP3.
- Music uploads **must** be named in the following format: **First Name Last Name - Category Program Type**
- First and Last Name **must** match the athlete's name as written on their Uplifter profile.

Category Program Type includes:

- **Category** (ie: STAR 5)
- **Discipline** (ie: Women/Girls, Men/Boys)
- **Segment** (ie: Short Program or Free Program, if applicable)
- **Age category** (ie: U10, if applicable)

Examples:

John Smith - STAR 5 Men 13&Over

Suzie Smith - PreNovice Women Short Program

All music used must be legally obtained and covered by the collective societies who manage music performance rights, reprography, and mechanical reproduction rights in Canada. Competitors who have music composed specifically for their programs either wholly or in part, that has been significantly mixed or altered from the original recording, are also responsible for obtaining the appropriate licenses to create a derivative work for the compositions and sound recordings selected.

**PLANNED PROGRAM SHEETS:**

Planned Program Content Sheets must be submitted electronically, by **Wednesday, September 16, 2026**, for ALL categories, except for: **STAR 2-4 Singles, Special Olympics, and Pattern Dances**.

NOTE: Skaters must complete a separate form for each program, including for combined categories. Dance/Pair teams please only submit one form per team.

Please complete the appropriate survey(s) below to submit. There will be a \$25 fee for missing, incomplete, or incorrect forms. **Planned Program Sheets will not be accepted in person at the Event.**

SCHEDULE:

A detailed schedule will be posted on the Skate Canada NL website as soon as possible after the registration deadline.

COACH ACCREDITATION:

Coaches must be a minimum of NCCP Regional Coach In-Training and be a current Professional Coaching Member of Skate Canada, in Good Standing.

MEDALS & MEDAL PRESENTATIONS (STAR 4 & higher):

Medals shall be awarded to the top three placements in each category. In a category where there are less than three entries, then the number of medals awarded shall equal the number of entries. Medal presentation times will be scheduled and posted in the Arena. **Skaters are asked to wear competition outfits and skates.**

MEDAL/CERTIFICATE PRESENTATIONS (STAR 2-3):

Presentation times will take place following the completion of each group.
